- You must apply for admission to the university as well as admission to the credential program. Although applications are accepted until the program is filled, priority is given to students that submit their applications according to the following dates:
Fall - Feb 28 and Spring - September 30
- You must submit the following five items with your initial application:
 1. **Application page**
 2. **Autobiography**
 3. **Official transcripts**
 4. **Fee receipt for \$50.00 application processing fee**
 5. **Certificate of Clearance (evidence that the C.O.C. application has been submitted to the state)**
