

## Subject Matter Preparation Program in Japanese

The single subject matter preparation program in Japanese consists of 30 semester units in Japanese with at least six units in each of four categories: Language, Culture, Linguistics, and Literature. The remaining six elective units may be selected from additional courses listed in one of the four categories.
