Process of Electing a Student Speaker:

- The Chicano/Latino Faculty Staff and Association members are open to nominate student speakers. They must submit the name of the students along with a one page biography by March 3, 2006 to the CLFSA secretary. Nominations will take place during the regular CLFSA meeting. During the month of March the Chicano Graduation Committee will select the student speaker. The student speaker must be notified no later than March 31, 2006 in order to allow sufficient time for the student to prepare.

The student speaker should meet the following criteria:

1. Open to students graduating with a Bachelors or Masters Degree in the 2005-2006 academic year.
2. Made significant contributions to Chicano/Latino community during their college years.
3. Must demonstrate leadership skills and campus involvement.
4. Undergraduates must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5; 3.2 for graduate students.
