Awarding of State University Grant will be made on a first-come, first-served basis if eligibility for funding exceeds the campus allocation

Important CSUF Policies Regarding Your SUMMER Award

When you receive summer financial aid funds, you acknowledge the following policies:

Policy One - California State University, Fullerton reserves the right to review, adjust or cancel financial aid awards at any time because of changes in federal, state, or CSUF availability of funds.

Policy Two - State University Grant funds are awarded on a first come, first served basis to cover 3 to 6 units of registration fees.

Policy Three - You must enroll in at least 3 units to be eligible for State University Grant.

Policy Four - Pell Grant is based on remaining academic year eligibility and may be adjusted according to the number of units in which you enroll.

Teaching credential students: To receive a Federal Pell Grant, you must be classified as a 'PBC' (post-baccalaureate credential) student by the CSUF Office of Admissions. In addition, you must be enrolled in at least 6 units of [teaching credential courses](#). Prerequisite or 'waiver' courses are not included in calculating your enrolled units for purposes of the Federal Pell Grant program.

Policy Five - You are responsible for paying summer registration fees if you do not receive financial aid to cover your summer charges in full. A hold may be placed on your ability to register for a future semester for any unpaid balance of your summer fees.

Policy Six - If you stop attending a class, you are responsible for following the withdrawal procedures and deadlines published in the summer class schedule. Withdrawal from one or more courses may result in cancellation or repayment of part or all of your aid.

Policy Seven - When the University prepares your disbursement, your fees will be paid first by applying your financial aid funds directly to your fee obligation. Any funds remaining will be prepared in the form of a "balance" check to be disbursed to you or sent to your banking account through Direct Deposit.

Policy Eight - Your eligibility is based on enrollment and summer educational expenses. You must be enrolled at least half-time (6 units equivalent) to be eligible for a Federal loan.

Graduate master's degree students: must be enrolled in the equivalent of 6 units of courses numbered 400 or higher (lower division courses do not earn unit credit and therefore do not meet the enrollment requirement).

Policy Nine - Your eligibility for financial aid programs is contingent upon your meeting [Satisfactory Academic Progress \(SAP\)](#) policies. You must complete the required number of units as described in the SAP Policy.

Policy Ten - Regulations governing financial aid are subject to change at any time without notice.

Policy Eleven - Your financial aid offer will be void and/or one or more financial aid programs (as appropriate) will be canceled if it is based on any error in determining eligibility for aid whether you or the Office of Financial Aid made the error.

Policy Twelve - If you withdraw from the University, any fee refund due will be returned to the appropriate financial aid account.

Policy Thirteen - If you received a summer grant payment and your enrollment status is reduced during the summer term, you may be billed for any overpaid amount.

Policy Fourteen - Your award may be adjusted or canceled due to changes in financial aid need, state residency, marital or academic status or if you fail to comply with State, Federal and University regulations.
