Good News! Have you registered for fall 2008 classes or do you plan to register soon? We are happy to inform you that your fee payment due date will be postponed based on your pending financial aid.

Here's how it works:

- In the Student Center (accessed through the Student Portal), under "Finances", look for the "account inquiry" link on the left side of the page. Click on this link for important information about your registration fees and other charges and pending financial aid.
- You will see a due date on the "charges due" tab. This date is established based on the date you register for classes. But, because you have been awarded financial aid, ***you are not required to pay your fees by this date and you will not be charged any penalties for late payment.***
- The first fall 2008 financial aid disbursement is scheduled for August 21, 2008. We will verify your eligibility for payment at that time and authorize your payment.
- If you have already paid some or all of your fees* before your financial aid disburses, your financial aid will apply as a refund toward your out-of-pocket expenses.
- Your financial aid payment will first go toward your outstanding charges. *If you do not have enough financial aid to cover your charges in full, you are responsible for paying any remaining balance.*
- If your financial aid disbursement exceeds your outstanding account balance, Student Financial Services will refund any remaining financial aid to you by check or "direct deposit". (Direct deposit is the safest, fastest way to receive your financial aid payment. Sign-up is available on-line through the Student Center.)
- Monitor your student account regularly to confirm your financial aid awards and your account balance. Until your financial aid is processed to pay your fees, your account balance will indicate that you still owe a balance. Once the payment transaction occurs, your balance will be updated.
- Remember: It is your responsibility to pay your registration fees if for any reason you do not receive sufficient funding from financial aid programs (including scholarships) to pay your full balance.

We look forward to assisting you with your registration fee payment.
