Good News! Your financial aid file is complete and we expect to be awarding you shortly. In the meantime, we have arranged for your registration fee payment to be postponed.

At the time you register for your classes, you will not be required to pay your fees. Once you have been awarded, if you have been offered grants, and/or accepted loans, your fees will be deducted from your financial aid.

How can you ensure your fees are paid on time?

- Check your financial aid application status regularly by logging into the New TITAN online through the [Student Portal](#). You will arrive at your “Student Center” where you may view your awards by clicking on the “Accept/Decline Awards” link, located on the left side of the page under Finances. Select aid year 2009 to view your “Award Package”.
- If you are offered a student loan to cover your fees, follow all instructions to accept the loan **AND** select a lender.
- If you decline your loan and do not have other financial aid, you are responsible for fee payment.
