FAQ Not Meeting SAP/SAP Appeal

- 1. Question: When do I know if I meet SAP Answer: SAP is ran yearly you will know if you are meeting after Spring semester; Keep in mind this may affect any Summer Financial aid
- Question: What if I don't meet SAP? Answer: You will be notified via email of the type of SAP you are not meeting (GPA, PACE, Unit Cap) You can complete the SAP appeal form and submit to see if you may be eligible for financial aid
- Where can I get the form? Answer: CSUF Office of FA website <u>https://www.fullerton.edu/financialaid/general/formsandappeals.php</u>
- 4. What do I submit with my SAP appeal? Answer: You will need to explain what happened in the academic year you did not meet SAP, what steps you are doing to change this, and provide any documentation such as doctor's note, work schedule, letters from professor/campus partners
- 5. What if I do not turn in the SAP appeal form? Answer: you will not be eligible for financial aid and you must pay out of pocket if you want to attend CSUF
- 6. What if I cannot afford to pay out of pocket? Answer: You can apply for a private loan, the private loan may take 6-8 weeks to process so make sure you turn in the private loan information in a timely manner <u>https://www.fullerton.edu/financialaid/general/formsandappeals.php</u>
- Can I do anything else to regain SAP eligibility on my own? Answer: Yes, you can attend another higher education institution, such as a community college to regain eligibly on your own
- I decided to go to a Community College, now what? Answer: Make sure you request your official transcripts from the institution and send them to CSUF so the office of Financial Aid can complete a recalculation
- Do I need to complete a form? Answer: Yes, please complete the SAP Correction/Update form and turn in to the Office of Financial Aid <u>https://www.fullerton.edu/financialaid/general/formsandappeals.php</u>
- 10. What if I decide to stop attending CSUF, what happens then?

Answer: You can stop out for 1 semester, if you stop out for more than 1 semester you lose CSUF student status

11. What happens if I come back within 1 semester?

Answer: No paperwork necessary. students appear as active and they will have an enrollment appointment window for the next semester
