




## Do I have Java Installed?

# Internet Explorer

Steps	Images
<p><b>Step One</b></p> <hr/> <p>Click on the <b>Settings</b> icon (  ) on the far right. Select <b>Internet Options</b> from the drop-down menu.</p>	
<p><b>Step Two</b></p> <hr/> <p>Under the <b>Security</b> tab click on the <b>Custom level</b> button.</p>	
<p><b>Step Three</b></p> <hr/> <p>Scroll down to the <b>Scripting</b> section.</p> <p>Look for the <b>Scripting of Java applets</b> section</p> <p>Click on <b>Enable</b>.</p> <p>Click <b>OK</b> when finished.</p>	




# Mozilla Firefox

---




# Google Chrome

---

Steps	Images
<p><b>Step One</b></p> <p>In the browser bar, enter: <b>chrome://settings/content.</b></p>	
<p><b>Step Two</b></p> <p>Find the <b>JavaScript</b> header, and click the corresponding arrow to the right.</p>	
<p><b>Step Three</b></p> <p>If JavaScript is <b>Blocked</b>, click the slider button to the right to change it to <b>Allowed (recommended)</b>.</p>	

# Safari

Steps	Images
<p><b>Step One</b></p> <p>Open <b>Safari</b>. Click <b>Safari</b> and select <b>Preferences</b>.</p>	
<p><b>Step Two</b></p> <p>Under the <b>Security</b> tab in the <b>Internet plug-ins</b> section, make sure <b>Allow plug-ins</b> is checked. Then, click on <b>Website Settings</b>.</p>	
<p><b>Step Three</b></p> <p>Click on <b>Java</b> on the left panel. Make sure the setting is set to <b>Ask</b>. Click <b>Done</b> when you are finished.</p>
