If you spot

- Odd wording or grammar.
- Suspicious links or attachments.
- External Sender Banner.

It may be a phishing email!

How to Protect Yourself

- Be skeptical of urgent messages especially those requesting action.
- Hover over links to check where they lead.
- Don't open suspicious attachments.

Report the email using "Report Suspicious" button on the orange email banner.

Cybersecurity Awareness Month!






Breast Cancer & Men's Health Awareness
