



FINISH IN FOUR PROGRAM

Students committed to graduating in four years, must be a freshman and enter in the Fall Semester meeting the following conditions:

1. Students must take the required ELM/EPT examinations, prior to Fall class registration. Students must complete all college preparatory courses during their first year to continue in the Finish in Four Program.
2. Students must successfully complete a minimum of 12 units per semester and 30 units towards degree completion annually. Applicable Advanced Placement work may be applied to the total units completed per year.
3. Students enrolled in college preparatory courses during their first year will need to complete courses during summer and/or winter intersession during their first year to successfully complete their degree within four years.
4. Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA and a 2.0 GPA in their major.
5. Finish in Four Checklist:
 - Meet each semester with their assigned Finish in Four advisors, and must complete the necessary paperwork by the posted deadline(s),
 - Reach agreement with their advisor regarding appropriate courses of study,
 - Consider the availability of future course offerings as related to graduation requirements,
 - Participate each Semester in the priority registration process and pay fees by the required deadline
 - Enrol in required courses at those times (which may include evening and weekend hours) when they are offered and/or available,
 - Remain in the same major they selected when they entered the University, unless they have written permission from the Finish in Four Coordinator,
 - Take and pass the Upper Division Writing Exam during their Junior year,
 - Check their CSU Fullerton e-mail account and Finish In Four website on a consistent basis,
 - Participate in one (1) Finish in Four sponsored personal development activity per year,
6. Students eligible for financial assistance must meet academic progress requirements and must meet the financial aid application deadline requirements each year to continue to receive financial assistance.
7. Students enrolled in the CSU Fullerton Finish in Four Program must demonstrate accountability by complying with all administrative, judicial, and academic policies and procedures. Non-compliance may result in cancellation of the pledge agreement.
8. Students must participate in a minimum of one (1) Finish in Four personal development activity per year.

* Students may petition the cancellation of the guideline agreement for serious and compelling reasons.
