



# Top 5 Tips

## for New Transfer Students to CSUF

### 1) Be CSU GE Certified or IGETC Certified!

Talk to your community college advisor about the certification process and how it can help you make the transition

### 2) Turn in your official transcripts as soon as possible!

This can lead to earlier knowledge of what classes you still need to complete at CSUF

### 3) Familiarize yourself with your CSUF Student Portal!

Get a head start at how to navigate your student center, register for classes, track degree progress through Titan Degree Audit (TDA), and more!

### 4) Visit the campus!

Get to know your surroundings. Cal State Fullerton is a large school with many resources for its students. Know what is available before you get here.

### 5) Attend Transfer Student Orientation!

New Student Orientation is held just for you. You will have the opportunity to meet with a major and GE advisor to learn about your degree requirements and more.
