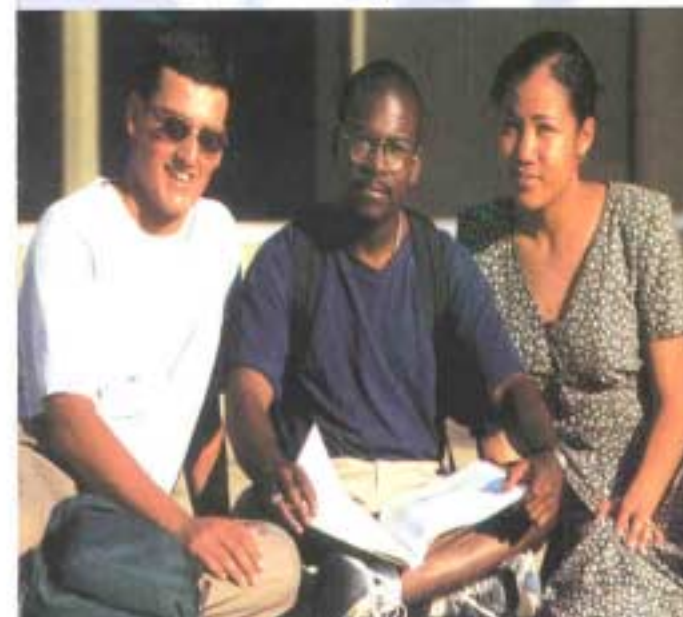

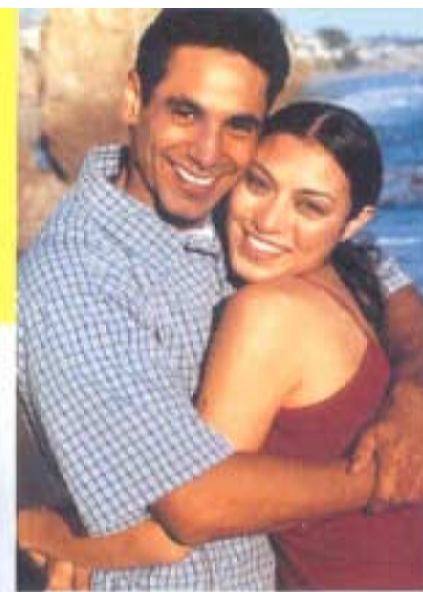

What Is The Summer Bridge Program?

It's a five-week, residential program during late June and the month of July for 140 incoming EOP students at Cal State Fullerton. Students in the program will attend English, Math and/or other GE classes during the program with week-ends off. There is no cost to students participating in the program; all meals and lodging are provided.

Who Should Apply for Summer Bridge?

Students who want to improve their chances for success at the university and students who think they may not qualify for admission to CSUF should apply. Note: Summer Bridge is an admissions requirement for some students.



How Will I Benefit from the Program?

As a Summer Bridge student, you will:

1. Jump start your success by attending university classes in math, English and/or other general education areas.
2. Improve your study skills.
3. Attend an exciting variety of on-campus lectures, cultural entertainment, and special events.
4. Receive introductions and invitations to join various student clubs and organizations.
5. Work with professionals who will help you grow as an individual, as well as a student.
6. Meet new friends and create a support system.
7. Get to know faculty and staff members at Cal State Fullerton.
8. Gain confidence to begin the fall semester.

What Should I Do To Be Considered for the Program?

- Apply to Cal State Fullerton and mark **Box 14** for EOP on the application.
- Apply for financial aid before the **March deadline**. Call the Financial Aid Office at CSUF for more info at 714-278-3125, or log on to www.fullerton.edu.
- Fill out and return the Summer Bridge application to the address listed at the bottom of the application.
- Take the required Cal State Math and English Placement Tests (ELM/EPT) no later than **May 4**.
- Meet with your EOP counselor to register for summer classes and choose your fall classes before **June 15**.
