Information Resources:

Description. Numbers of volumes and journals held by the institution's library(s), together with library acquisitions expenditures; numbers of various types of computing resources available to students and staff, together with instructional equipment and computing-related expenditures.

Issues and Alternatives. As noted, standard definitions are not available for many of these categories and, in the case of library resources, those that are established may be obsolescent. As a result, institutions may consider providing:

- Additional statistics about information resources that better reflect electronic media, ability to tap on-line databases, inter-library agreements that provide access to additional materials for students as staff, etc.
- Statistics on library and information usage by students, faculty, staff, and other users.

SFX can provide context sensitive linking from a variety of electronic indexes and databases to relevant full text from journals or electronic books. Since Cal State Fullerton has also provided information about paper journals, patrons can be guided to inhouse sources as well. In 2009, according to SFX statistics for journals licensed by CSU Fullerton or by the Chancellor's Office for all CSUs, there were over 55,000 full-text journals in over 200 different packages available to students at Cal State Fullerton (some journals may be in more than one package) and there were over 9900 paper journals.
