Application must be accompanied by a personal statement (500 words or less) demonstrating how your career goals are congruent with your current activities, employment, etc. and your plans for the future in the field. In addition you must include at least one letter of recommendation from a faculty or staff member.

Applications are to be turned in by **April 17th at 5pm** in the WoMen's and Adult Reentry Center, GH 205. Notification of award will be sent early May and financial award will distributed fall 2020.
