"Table"

Arts: This is categorized as "Fine and Applied Arts" in the Statistical Abstract. The majors that fall into this category are Art, Fine Art, Art History, Music, Music Performance, Music Education, Drama, Theatre Arts Performance, and Dance.

Business & Management: This is categorized as "Business and Management" in the Statistical Abstract. The majors that fall into this category are Accounting, Taxation, Business Administration, Business Economics, Finance, Management, International Business, Management Science, Marketing, Speech - Public Relations, Entrepreneurship, Entertainment and Tourism, E-Commerce, and Information Technology.

Comm.: This is categorized as "Communications" in the Statistical Abstract. The majors that fall into this category are Communications, Advertising, Radio/TV/Film, Photocommunications, Entertainment Studies, and Journalism.

Educ.: This is categorized as "Education" in the Statistical Abstract. The majors that fall into this category are Child and Adolescent Studies, Counseling, Kinesiology and Health Promotion, Reading, Educational Leadership, Elementary Education, Bilingual Education, Secondary Education, Instructional Design & Technology, Special Education, and Education Technology.

Engineering: This is categorized as "Engineering" in the Statistical Abstract. The majors that fall into this category are General Engineering, Civil and Environmental Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Engineering Science, Systems Engineering and Computer Engineering.

Health Professions: This is categorized as "Health Professions" and "Home Economics" in the Statistical Abstract. The majors that fall into this category are Speech - Communicative Disorders, Health Sciences, Nursing, and Public Health.

Humanities & Social Sciences: This is categorized as "Area Studies," "Foreign Languages," "Letters," "Psychology," "Social Sciences" and "Interdisciplinary Studies" in the Statistical Abstract. The majors that fall into this category are American Studies, Latin American Studies, Russian Studies, European Studies, French, German, Japanese, Spanish, Speech, Comparative Literature, English, English as a Second Language, Linguistics, Philosophy, Comparative Religion, Psychology, Clinical Psychology, Economics, Afro-Ethnic Studies, Asian American Studies, Chicano Studies, Geography, History, Political Science, Sociology, Social Science, Math/Science Education, Liberal Studies, Women's Studies, Special Major, Ethnic Studies and Environmental Studies.

Info. Sciences: This is categorized as "Computer and Information Sciences" or "Information Sciences" in the Statistical Abstract. The majors that fall into this category are Information Systems and Decision Science, Computer Science and Computer Software.

Natural Science & Mathematics: This is categorized as "Biological Sciences," "Mathematics" and "Physical Sciences" in the Statistical Abstract. The majors that fall into this category are Biological Sciences, Chemistry, Chemistry/Biochemistry, Geological Sciences, Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, Statistical Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/Geochemistry.

Public Affairs: This is categorized as "Public Affairs and Services" in the Statistical Abstract. The majors that fall into this category are Human Services, Criminal Justice, Gerontology and Public Administration.

Undec./Cred. Only: This is categorized as "Undeclared" in the Statistical Abstract and the table is footnoted to mention that students seeking credentials only were not included. This number is found by taking the difference of the total number of students and subtracting the number given on the stat Abstract table. Also, from 1972-1978, Library Science was offered as a major. These students are included in this category as well.

"Discrepancies"

Minor discrepancies in numbers were found between information from the 3.39 table in the CSUF Statistical handbooks and the information from the Statistical Abstract. These discrepancies, shown on this table, are generally within ten students except in the case of students who are undeclared or seeking a credential only. Due to the differences in coding credential seeking students, there is no way to resolve the difference and it has been deemed acceptable. From 1997 on, the only differences were found in the case of undeclared and credential only students. Beginning in Fall 2002, each year's discrepancies are shown because CSUF data is available before the Statistical Abstract. Once the Chancellor's Office data is available the numbers are changed to reflect the new data. The originally posted numbers are then moved to this table.

Fall 2004: The grand total for Fullerton reported by the Chancellor's Office Academic and Support Programs:Statistical Abstract Section IV: Student Majors differed from the grand total reported in the Chancellor's Office Statistical Abstract Section I: Systemwide and Campus Enrollment table for Fall 2004. The CSUF Statistical Handbook Table 3.39 grand total matched the Chancellor's Office Section I amount. Therefore, the total enrollment for Fall 2004 reported by CSUF and confirmed by the Chancellor's Office Statistical Abstract Section I: Systemwide and Campus Enrollment table will continue to be used.

Fall 2005: The grand total for Fullerton reported by the Chancellor's Office Statistical Abstract Section IV: Academic and Support Programs: Student Majors differed from the grand total reported in the Chancellor's Office Statistical Abstract Section I: Systemwide and Campus Enrollment table again in Fall 2005. CSUF's grand total matches the Chancellor's Office Section I amount and will continue to be used.

Fall 2007: The Chancellor's Office total for Health Professions (1413) differs from CSUF's number by 141. This amount equals the number of PRENURSE students enrolled in Fall 2007. The grand total for Fullerton reported by the Chancellor's Office Statistical Abstract Section IV: Academic and Support Programs: Student Majors differed from the grand total reported in the Chancellor's Office Statistical Abstract Section I: Systemwide and Campus Enrollment table again in Fall 2007. CSUF's grand total matches the Chancellor's Office Section I amount and will continue to be used.
