All data was derived from either the 1.55 table of the statistical handbook of the indicated semester or from the Statistical Report of the California State Colleges, Part D: Academic Year Summary for the indicated semester.

\* Indicates that data was taken from a table other than the 1.55 statistical handbook table for the semester or the systemwide statistical report for the semester because the 1.55 and systemwide were both unavailable or the totals (on both) were wrong. The data from Spring 1981 was taken from the 1.01 stat handbook table. The data from Fall 1981 was taken from the 3.25 stat handbook table. The data from Fall 1982 was taken from the 3.36 stat handbook table.
