* "with PhD" was calculated using data in the payroll data base, Fall, 1980 through Fall, 1990. The payroll data base does not have clean, updated information on terminal degree. Starting in Fall, 1991, data from Faculty Records were used to calculate "with PhD." Thus, the increase is due to improved data quality and not a change in faculty characteristics.

Not included in above counts: ARTS - 4 FERPS at 1/2 time; BAE - 1 FERP at 1/2 time, 4 regular tenured/track faculty on full or partial leave, 1 regular tenured/track faculty on pre-retirement time base change; COMM - 1 FERP at 1/2 time, 1 regular tenured/track faculty on pre-retirement time base change; HDCS - 1 FERP at 1/2 time, 2 regular tenured/track faculty on full leave; HSS - 10 FERPS at 1/2 time, 9 regular tenured/track faculty on full or partial leave, 1 regular tenured/track faculty on pre-retirement time base change; NSM - 2 FERPS at 1/2 time and 1 Fall FERP on full leave. Total = 18 regular tenured/track faculty and 20 FERPS.
