\* "with PhD" was calculated using data in the payroll data base, Fall, 1980 through Fall, 1990. The payroll data base does not have clean, updated information on terminal degree. Starting in Fall, 1991, data from Faculty Records were used to calculate "with PhD." Thus, the increase is due to improved data quality and not a change in faculty characteristics.

Not included in above counts:   **ARTS** - 3 FERPS at 1/2 time, 3 tenured/track faculty on full or partial leave, including 1 Fall FERP leave;  
**CBE** - 1 FERP at 1/2 time, 3 tenured/track faculty on full or partial leave, 1 regular tenured/track faculty on administrative leave; **COMM** - 1 FERP at 1/2 time, 1 AY FERP leave; **ECS** - 1 FERP at 1/2 time, 1 tenured/track faculty on full or partial leave; **EDUC** - 2 tenured/track faculty on full or partial leave; **HDCS** - 1 FERP at 1/2 time, 1 tenured/track faculty on full or partial leave; **H&SS** - 16 FERPS at 1/2 time, 5 tenured/track faculty on full or partial leave, including 1 Fall FERP leave, 1 regular tenured/track faculty on administrative leave; **NSM** - 1 FERP at 1/2 time, 1 AY FERP leave and 1 Fall FERP leave. **Total** = 13 regular tenured/track faculty on full or partial leave; 2 regular tenured/track faculty on administrative leave; 24 FERPS; and 5 FERP leaves (3 Fall and 2 AY).
