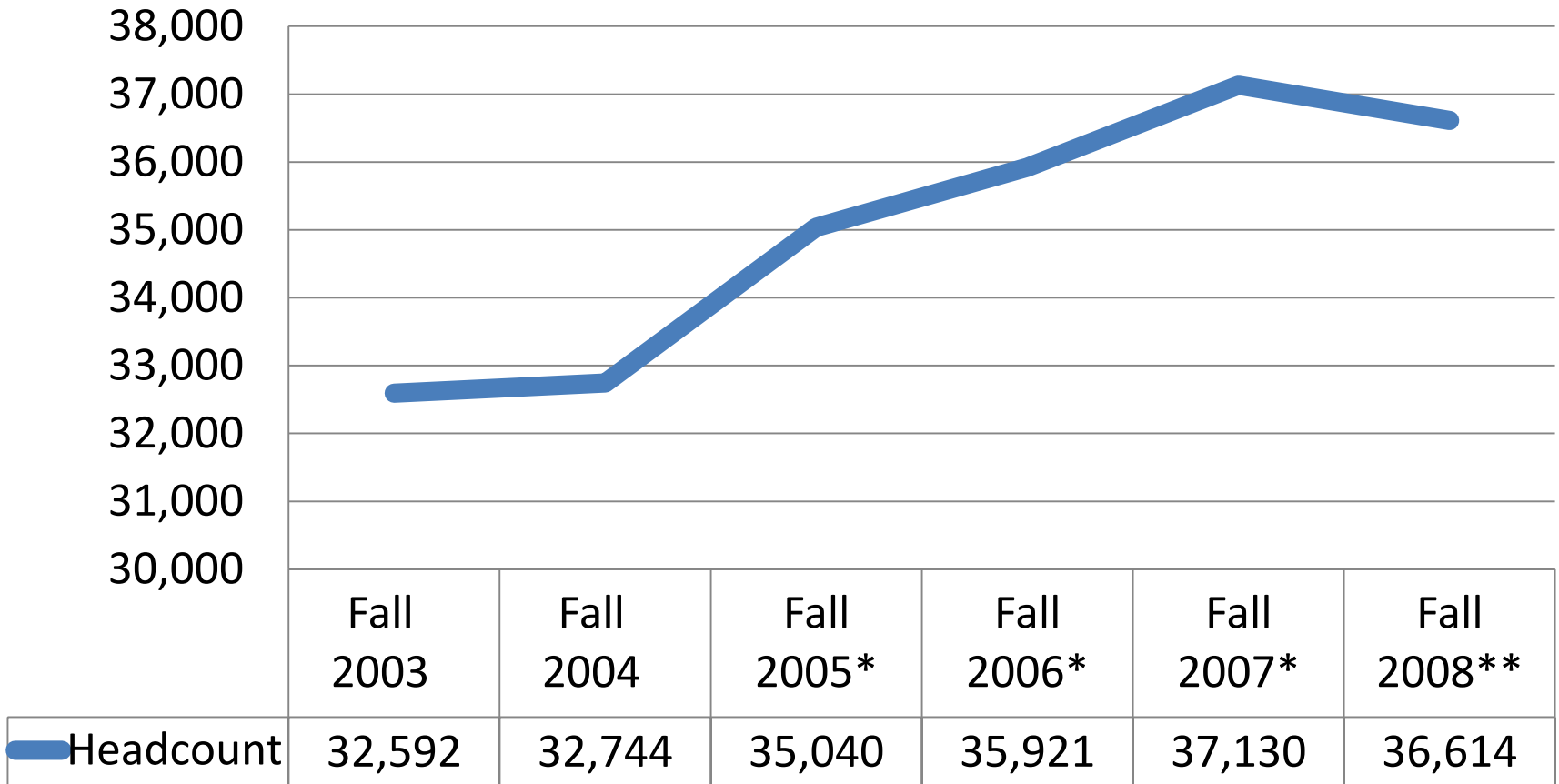

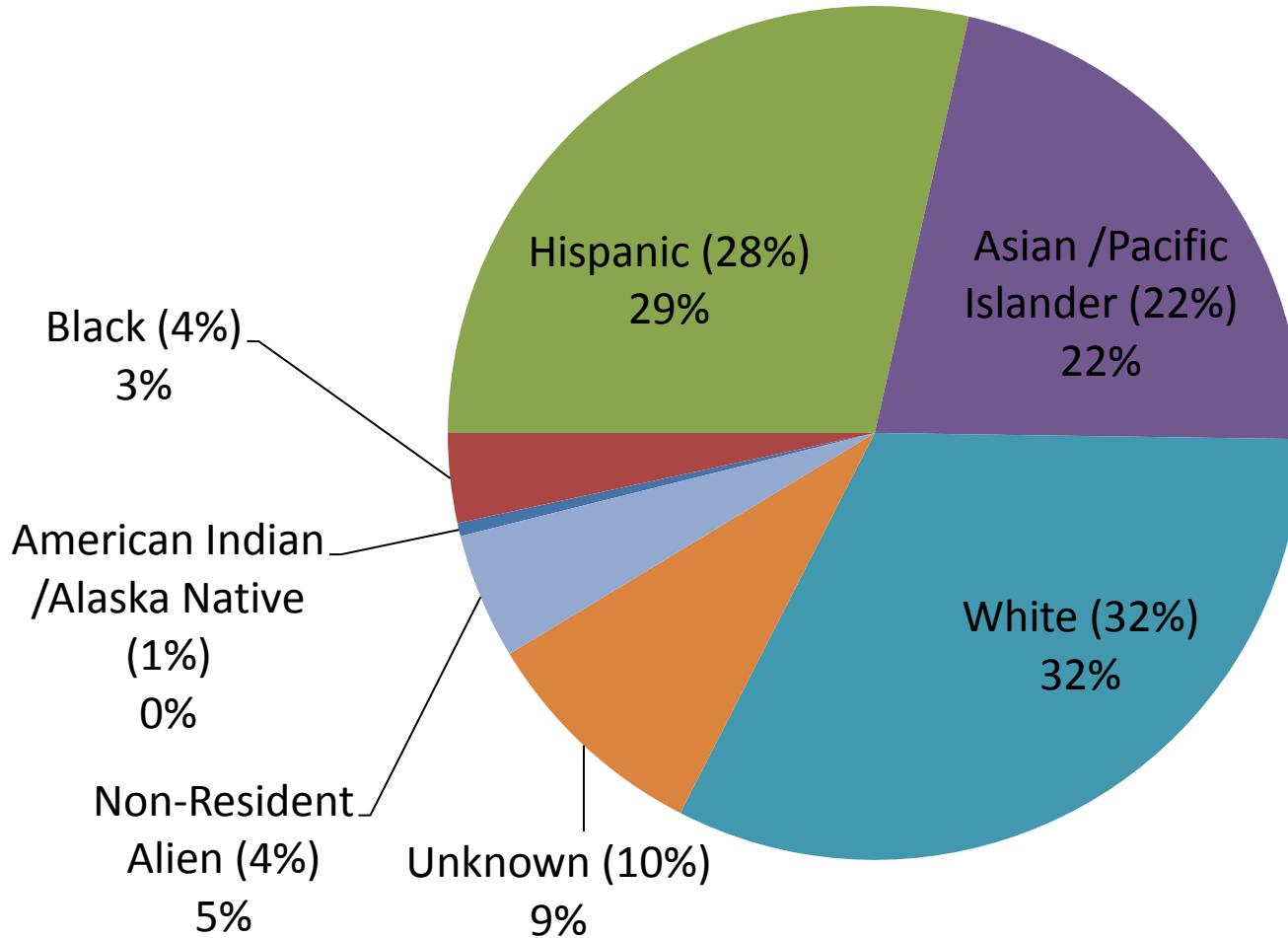
Fall Enrollment Comparisons (Headcount)



*We had the largest headcount enrollment of all CSUs in Fall 2005, 2006, 2007

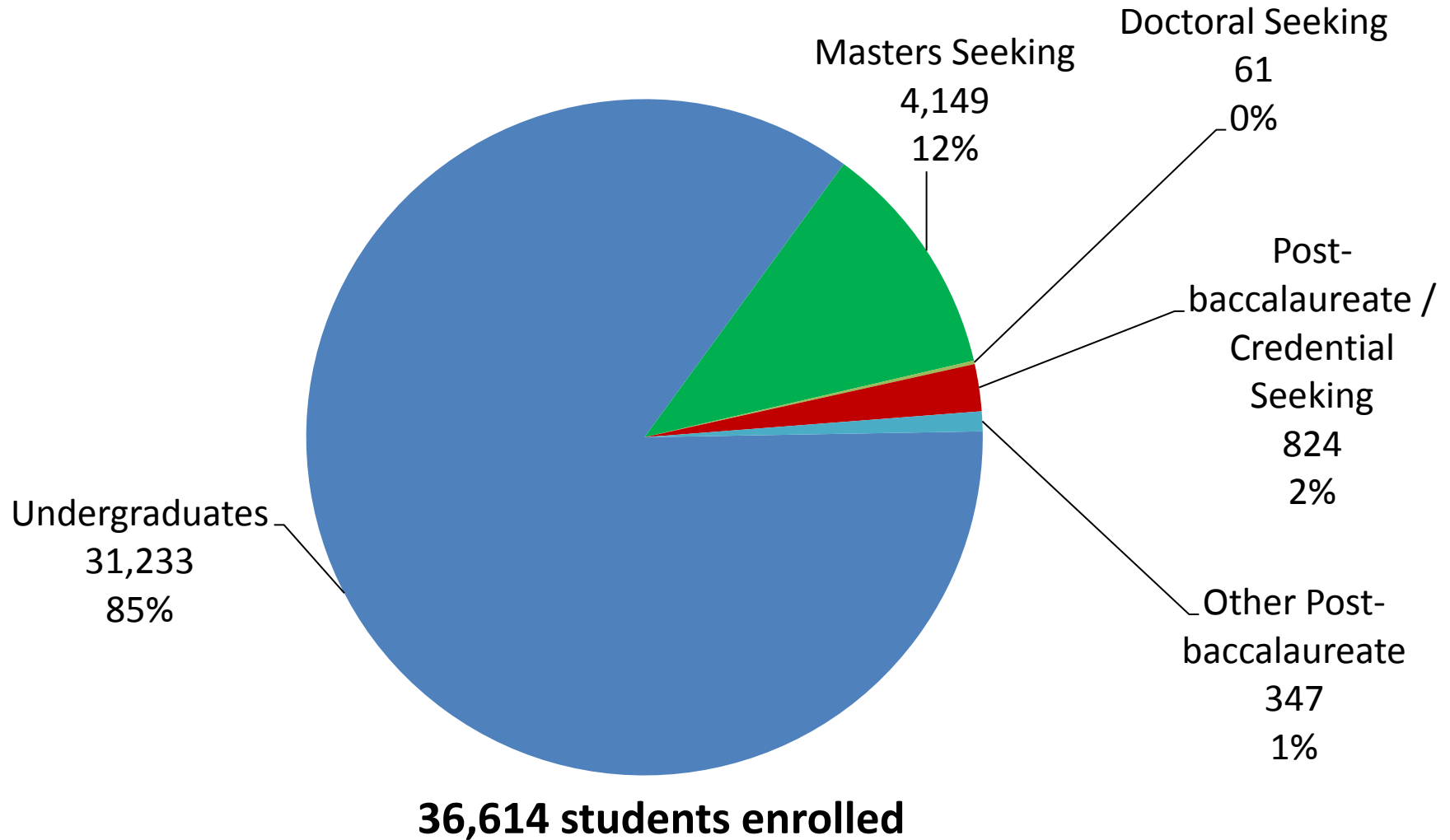

Fall 2008* Ethnic Distribution



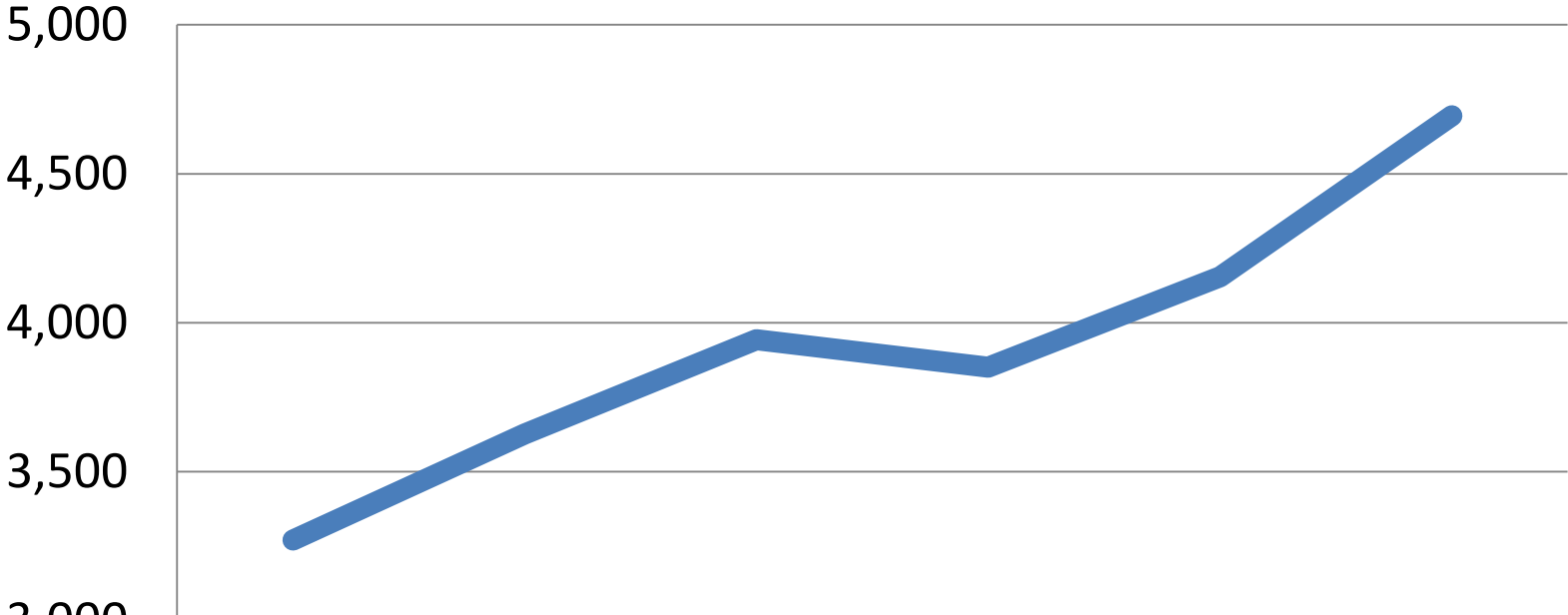

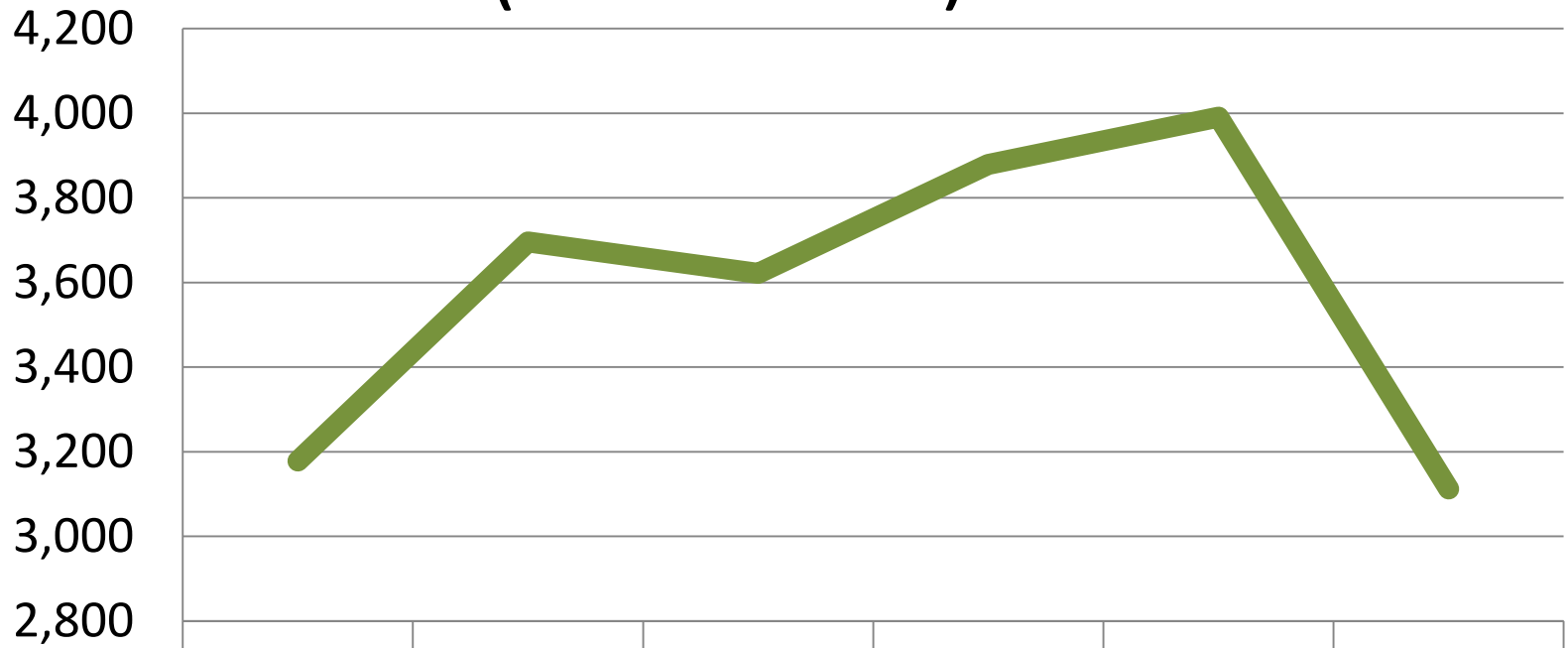

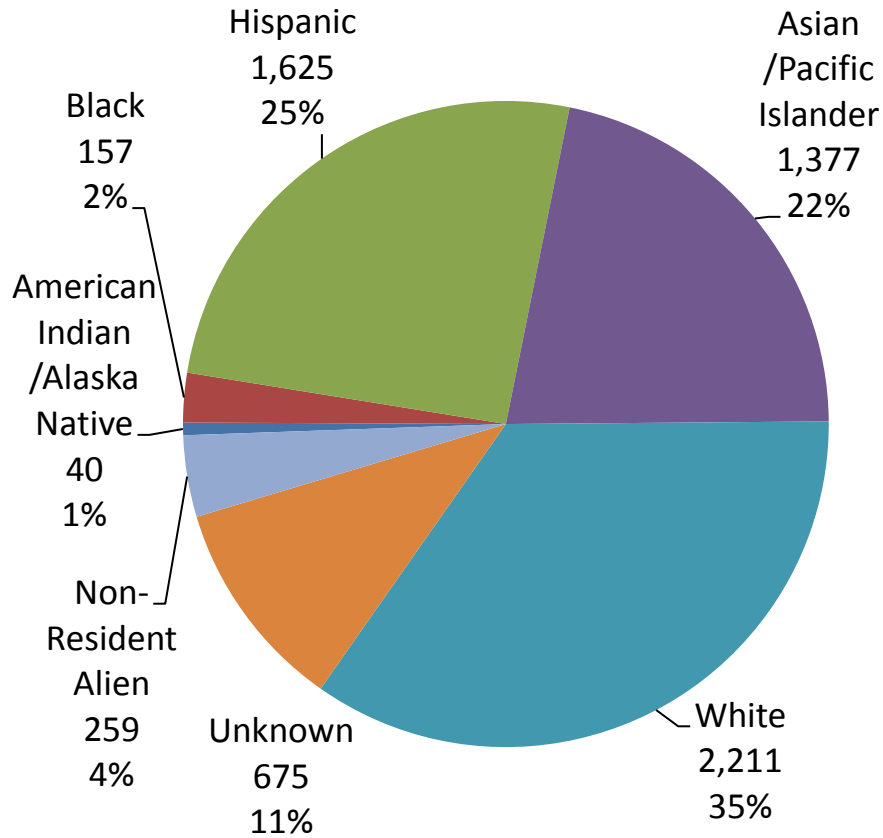

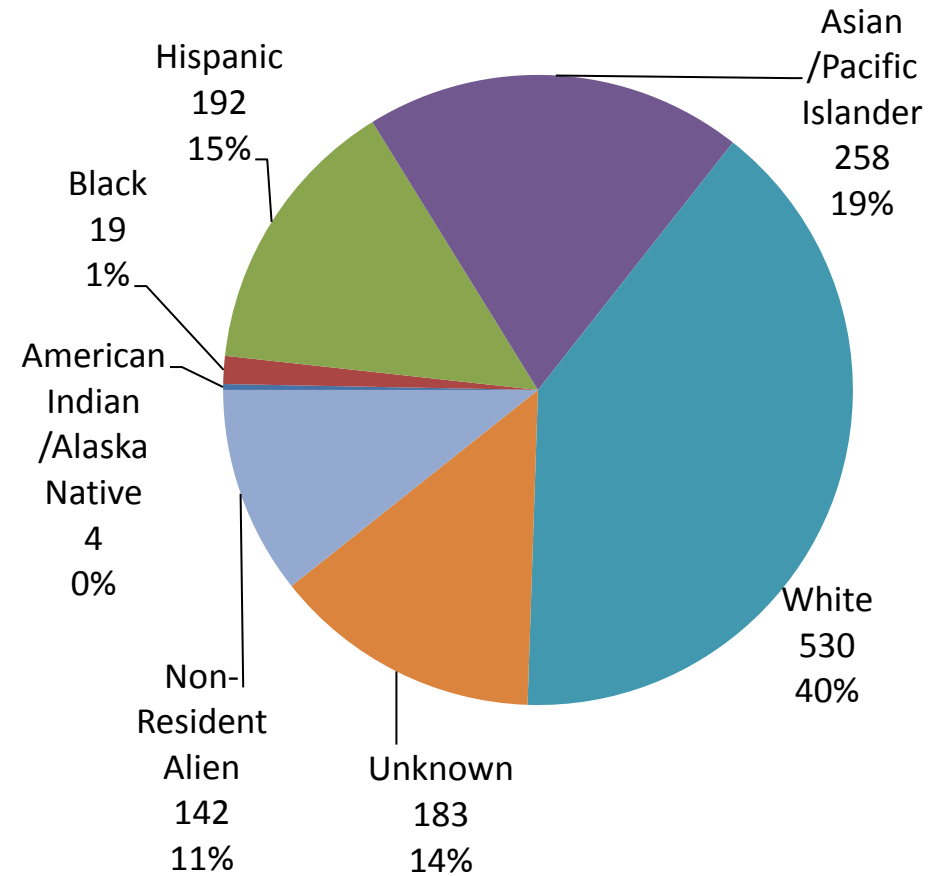
