ART 495: This class is a combination of students working within an internship (120-hours per term) and preparing for future internships and job opportunities. Students complete a resume (along with edits), digital portfolios, websites, and an online Mock Interview; and participate in a Portfolio Review with professionals in their fields. This is an online class with most of the activities completed by students independently with guidance from their professor. If possible, please work to obtain an internship before the class begins.
