BACKGROUND: Directly from the U.K. Seivewright presents his premiere California performance in Cal State Fullerton's Meng Concert Hall. He has performed extensively throughout Great Britain, Ireland, Norway, Germany, Belgium, Denmark, Latvia, Estonia, Vietnam, Kazakhstan, Australia, China, Kuwait, the U.S. and Russia, being heard in many of the world's best-known concert halls including the National Concert Hall (Hanoi, Vietnam), the Melba Hall (Melbourne, Australia), the Concert Hall of the Forbidden City (Beijing, China) and Russia's Philharmonic Hall in Arkhangelsk. He has appeared with a number of leading British orchestras and with symphonies in Europe, China and India. He has offered numerous premieres, including John Ireland's *Piano Concerto* with the State Academic Symphony Orchestra of the Republic of Kazakhstan during their tour throughout the former countries of the Soviet Union. Recent recitals include his first appearance at the International Bach Academy in Boston.

His extensive discography includes *The Complete Piano Music of Carl Nielsen* (2CDs - Naxos), *Contemporary Scottish Piano Music* (Merlin) and the major piano works of Danish Romantic composer Victor Bendix (Rondo Records, Copenhagen). Currently he is working on a series of CDs for Divine Art featuring all 90 Piano Sonatas of Baldassarre Galuppi.
