

TRANSFER STUDENTS TRANSITION CHECKLIST:

BEFORE APPLYING TO CSUF

Pass the Golden Four with a “C” or better prior to your last semester at the community college. If you are planning to take one of these courses your last semester at the community college, CSUF cannot admit you until the grade is recorded and verified. To avoid this delay you should plan your courses so that the following four G.E. requirements are completed prior to the last semester. (See your advisor for specific courses that satisfy these categories)

You must have 60 semester units (or 84 quarter units) completed to be admitted to CSUF. These units will include the Golden Four, lower division major requirements, general education (at least 30 semester units) and recommended subject matter preparation courses.

Check your cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA): It must be 2.0 or higher for California residents.

You must be in good standing at the last college or university attended.

See a transfer counselor at the community college to work on the correct coursework for general education certification.

See your Admissions and Records department to request CSU General Education Certification. The University and the CCT recommend students to transfer with their GE Certification.

Make an advising appointment with the Cal State Fullerton CCT representative who visits your campus to ensure you are taking the correct coursework for your lower division major requirements and subject matter preparation. You can also verify these classes through the school catalogs and through www.assist.org.

Apply to Cal State Fullerton on line at www.csumentor.edu . For spring admissions the priority application period begins August 1st until August 31st; for fall admissions priority applications are due starting October 1st until November 30th.

TRANSITION TO CSUF:

Send your in-progress transcripts after you receive a letter from CSUF asking for them.

Send the final transcripts as soon as your final semester grades are recorded.

AFTER ADMISSION TO CSUF:

Check the CCT website for recommended first semester courses.

Attend a Center for Careers in Teaching seminar early in your first semester. The dates, times and locations are posted on our website at www.fullerton.edu/cct

See your major advisor at CSUF.
