b. Earth/Space Science	GEOL 102
c. Life Science	BIOL 102
3. Implications and Explorations :	CHAD: BIOL 305 is an option in the major
<p>Note: For best CSET preparation, students should take one course from 2.a, 2.b and 2.c. The 102 courses are highly recommended for future elementary teachers but any course from the GE list in these sections will contribute significant content knowledge. CHAD majors may take BIOL 305 as an option. These 3 units offer additional preparation in life science. The CHAD major who takes one class from 2.a, 2.b and 2.c should consider major alternatives to BIOL 305.</p> <p>NOTE: at least two courses from 2.a, 2.b, 2.c must be from the 102 series.</p>
