Recommended timeframe for setting up a service-learning course is indicated below in the number of months prior to the start of the course. We encourage faculty to work within these timeframes so that CICE can provide excellent service and guidance.

5-9 months	Identify type of service-learning component desired: individual placements for each student, a single class project, multiple group projects, problem based, discipline based, etc.	Available for consultation, examples and referrals to service-learning faculty.

5-6 months	Identify desired placement sites. If assistance is needed, contact Dawn Macy at x7450.	Assists with site identification and begins registration process for sites not currently approved.
4-5 months	Make contact with sites if necessary. CICE staff can assist with this if requested.	Help verify site appropriateness. Assists in researching new sites if needed.
