## Advanced Practicum/ Academic Internships (CAS 394L, 464L, 474L, 494L)



The Child & Adolescent Studies Advanced Seminar/ Practicum is required for all CHAD majors. Fieldwork emphasizes the integration of academic and hands-on learning. Students may complete internships in a variety of settings including education, mental health and social work contexts.

Students must complete a minimum of 4 hours per week for a total of 60 hours over the course of a semester. The grade option for the course is credit/ no credit only.

### What is an Academic Internship?

At Cal State Fullerton, academic internships are credit-bearing. Students enroll in an internship course and complete course requirements. The number of units you receive depends on the number of hours you complete at your internship site.

1 unit = 40-60 hours, 2 units = 80-100 hours,  
3 units = 120-150 hours

An academic internship is a work-learning partnership between a student, the university, and a host company or organization that bears a direct relationship to a student's major and professional goals.
