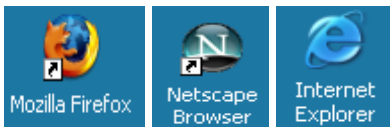

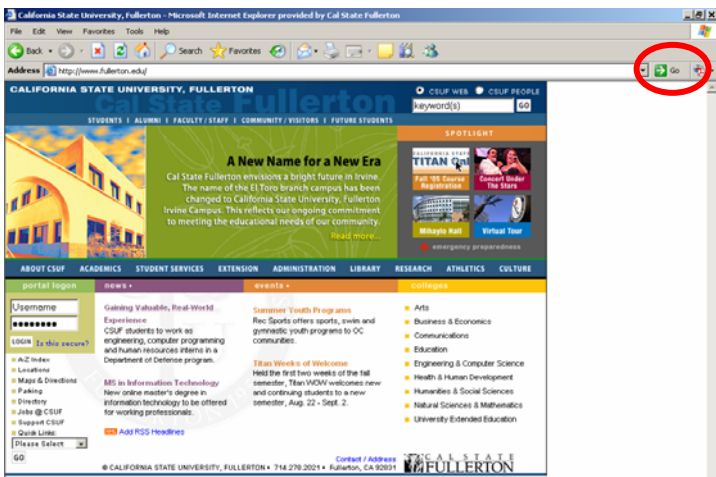
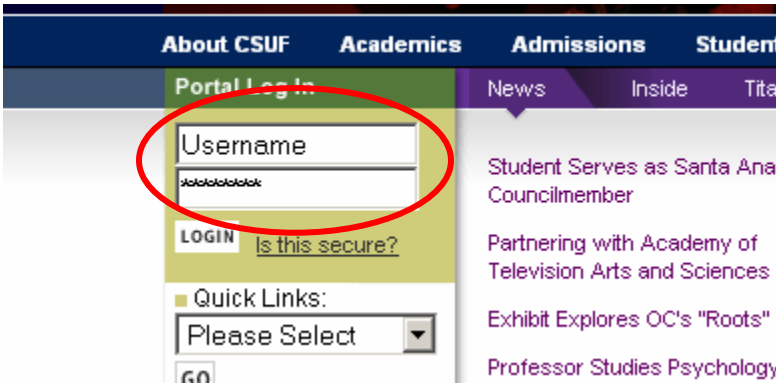
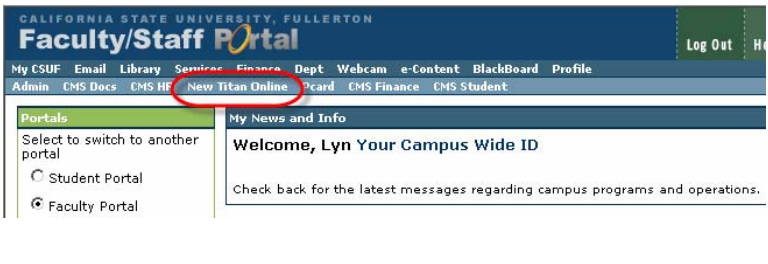


<p>Step 1:</p> <p>Launch Internet Explorer (or your browser preference) from your desktop.</p>	
<p>Step 2:</p> <p>Your home page opens. If your home page is not the CSUF website, type www.fullerton.edu in the address bar and click  or select 'enter' on your keyboard.</p>	
<p>Step 3:</p> <p>Under "Portal Log In", enter your campus assigned username and password.</p> <p>Click LOGIN.</p>	
<p>Step 4:</p> <p>Click on the "New Titan Online" tab.</p>
