

Spring 2019 Undergraduate Exit Survey: Findings at a Glance

(n = 3014, 40% response rate)

Plan After Graduation:

- Current / New Employment 90%
- Continue Education 43%

WSCUC Core Competencies (“My CSUF education helped improve my ability...”):

- Quantitative Reasoning 65%
- Written & Oral Communication; Critical Thinking; Information Literacy 86-89%

CSUF Degree Personal Impact (“My CSUF degree helped me...”):

- Goal prep 86%
- Work prep 88%
- Different views 86%
- Own biases 86%
- Community impact 73%
- Lifelong learner 88%

Time to Graduation:

- 49% took LONGER than planned to graduate

Satisfaction with Time to Graduation:

- 64% All students
- 38% Students who took longer to graduate

Work More Than 20 Hours Per Week (avg. in year 1-3):

- 45% All students
- 52% Students who took longer to graduate

Top Challenges Delaying Graduation:

- Class Availability / Scheduling 22%
- Work 16%
- Change/add major, concentration 11%
- Financial 10%
- Uncertainty in major/career path 8%

Top Strategies Accelerating Graduation:

- Summer/Intersession Classes 38%
- Increased Course Load 34%
- Transferable Credits (HS/CC) 9%
- Advising/Counseling 8%
- Study Habits 7%

Co-Curricular Student participation (“I participated in...”):

- Internship 40%
- Student Organization 31%
- Supplemental Instruction 13%
- Athletic Events 13%
- ASI 11%
- No participation 25%

Co-Curricular Experiences:

- 75% students reported co-curricular experiences helpful to own success

Attend CSUF:

- 78% students reported “probably” or “definitely” would choose to attend CSUF again
