## FORUM RSVP SURVEY (N=74)

### RESULTS

A majority of respondents (91%) agreed or strongly agreed that CSUF has a sustainable university wide assessment process, and 78% agreed or strongly agreed that the campus culture accepts or is friendly to assessment.
