Applicants need to submit:

- A resume and two letters of recommendation - one from the chair or member of the committee on which the student serves and another from a member of the CSUF faculty, staff or administration who has knowledge of the student's contributions to the university.
- A 1-2 page statement that details the experience and knowledge the student has acquired by serving on a senate committee. Applicant should include personal or academic achievements, community service, future goals, and any information they consider relevant to their application. For example, students may attach the ASI Learning Goals Worksheet.
- Part-time graduate students should address their research and academic responsibilities and their relationship to Academic Senate committee service.
- A list of any CSUF on-campus organizations, to which the applicant belongs, including positions held, length of time in office, and projects and events the student has coordinated.
- Submit completed materials to MH-143, Academic Senate Office, (see details above)
