



Sidewalk Chalking Policy

FOR CURRENTLY RECOGNIZED AND ACTIVE CLUBS/ORGANIZATIONS ONLY

In addition to posting flyers and banners on campus, another option for promoting student club and organization events is through sidewalk chalking. Questions and/or comments may be directed to the Associate Dean for Student Life at (657) 278-7622.

Sidewalk Chalking Policy and Guidelines:

- 1) Sidewalk chalking space may be used for informational purposes similar to the usage of banner space on specified areas.
- 2) Permitted chalking locations:
 - Titan Walkway
 - Central Quad
 - NE/NW, SE/SW Corners of the Quad
 - In front of McCarthy Hall/North entrance
 - In front of Langsdorf Hall/between 2nd floor Patio Steps and Bicycle Racks
 - In front of Humanities/West entrance
 - In front of Education Classroom/South entrance
 - In front of Engineering Building
 - In front of Kinesiology Health Science/South entrance
- 3) Student organizations must reserve space through the Student Organization Resource Center. Space may be reserved for a 2-week period only.
- 4) Student organizations must provide their own chalk. Chalk must be non-toxic and water-soluble only.
- 5) Student organizations utilizing sidewalks to promote events or communicate messages should be sensitive to the larger campus community. Please be conscientious of content and images. The Dean of Students Office reserves the right to request that the chalking be removed if the content or images are determined to be offensive or inappropriate.
- 6) Chalk must be cleaned up and removed by the end of the allotted time. Student organizations are responsible for removing their chaked messages.
- 7) Penalty for not cleaning up/removing chaked messages: loss of sidewalk chalking privileges.
