Part-time Lecturer Pool in Engineering & Computer Science

The College of Engineering and Computer Science (ECS) at California State University, Fullerton (CSUF), seeks applications from highly qualified individuals to a pool from which the department can select candidates for teaching a variety of undergraduate and graduate courses in its five administrative units. Most teaching needs occur at last minute when a regular faculty member is unavailable to teach. Also, an adjunct faculty candidate with specialization not represented in the college can propose a graduate level or senior level elective courses.

Some of the classes are offered either late afternoon or evening making it feasible for working professionals while some courses are more appropriate for those of you with flexibility with your primary work since they are offered during the day time.

Proficiency with online teaching strategies and approaches may further enhance an applicant's candidacy.

Appointment Date and Academic Calendar

The need for part-time faculty is greatest in the Fall and Spring semesters. The fall term begins in late August and ends in mid-December; the spring term runs from the beginning of February through the end of May. On rare occasions, part-time faculty are needed during one of the Summer session segments.

Appointment and Salary

All part-time faculty appointments are made as Lecturers, under the terms of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the California State University system and the California Faculty Association. Initial appointments are for one semester only. Salaries vary depending upon qualifications and experience. Typical starting salaries for part-time faculty are in the mid-\$3000 range per course.
