The Summer Intern Program outline is as follows:

- Candidates must be at least 18 years of age and have attained Sophomore, Junior, Senior, or Graduate School status in a Technical or Professional discipline recruited by the Robinson Nevada Mining Company (Metallurgical / Chemical Engineering, Mining Engineering, Geology–Geological Engineering, Environmental engineering, Electrical Engineering/Instrumentation-Control, & Analytical Chemistry)
- Candidates will be interviewed either by phone or in person to ensure the most qualified students are offered Technical and Professional summer positions. All students will be evaluated during the employment period as required.
- Compensation will be a minimum of \$18.50/hour and will be eligible for overtime pay.
- The Robinson Nevada Mining Company will reimburse mileage, meals and lodging (if required) from your school location to Ely and back to your school location at the end of your internship.
- We will provide apartment or motel room in Ely during your summer intern assignment. Students will be responsible for meals.
- Steel toed shoes are required. If you do not have steel toed shoes, upon presentation of a receipt we will reimburse you up to the amount of \$100 for the purchase of the shoes.
- We will provide safety glasses and hard hats. If prescription safety glasses are required, upon presentation of a receipt we will reimburse you up to the amount of \$100 for the purchase of the prescription safety glasses.
