

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) Second Quarterly Report – September 30, 2021

(1) California State University, Fullerton signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the ARP (a)(4) program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

(2) California State University, Fullerton received \$59,579,150 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the ARP (a)(4) program.

(3) California State University, Fullerton has awarded \$48,021,500 to students under the ARP and (a)(4) program as of September 27, 2021.

(4) 39,955 students at California State University, Fullerton eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the ARP (a)(4) program.

(5) 39,617 students at California State University, Fullerton received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the ARP (a)(4) program.

(6) The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the ARP (a)(4) program are described below:

Grant amounts will automatically be provided to eligible students beginning on July 6, 2021 and proceeding through the month of July. Eligible students will be awarded one block grant depending on their Expected Family Contribution (EFC). Students without a FAFSA or CDA application on file will receive a Block 3 Grant.

HEERF III Block 1 Grant:

- Eligible EFC: \$0 - \$5,711
- Eligible award: \$1,750.00

HEERF III Block 2 Grant:

- Eligible EFC: Greater than \$5,711
- Eligible award: \$750.00

HEERF III Block 3 Grant:

- No financial aid application on file*
- Eligible award: \$500.00

This population of students includes international students, undocumented students without AB540 status, and students who did not fill out a 2020-21 financial aid application

(7) On June 30, 2021, the Office of Financial Aid at California State University, Fullerton sent an email to all eligible students with information on eligibility requirements and award amounts. The COVID-19 response website was also updated at that time with information on HEERF III. No applications were required of students in order to receive HEERF III funds.
