- Amount:** Up to six \$300 scholarships will be awarded.
- Open to:** This award is open to CSUF full-time (12 units) undergraduate and graduate students except previous AAPIFSA scholarship recipients.
- Criteria:** 3.0 cumulative GPA for undergraduate students • 3.5 cumulative GPA for graduate students • Academic achievement • Financial need • Community involvement in the local and/or campus Asian American and Pacific Islander community
- Application Procedure:**
1. Download application from the AAPIFSA Web Site at <http://www.fullerton.edu/aapifsa> or obtain a copy from the office of Ms. Kristine Dennehy Humanities 810F.
 2. Complete **page one** of the AAPIFSA application form.
 3. Write a 500-word, typed essay that responds to all the questions on **page two** of the AAPIFSA Application.
 4. Enclose the following supporting documents with your application:
 - a. One letter of recommendation from faculty or staff;
 - b. Copy of unofficial transcript or instructor-signed grade report if no transcript;
 - c. Financial aid award summary from Titan Online (if you are a financial aid recipient).

Application Criteria**

This award was established by the Asian American and Pacific Islander Faculty and Staff Association to recognize academic achievement, active involvement in the local and/or campus Asian American and Pacific Islander community and demonstrated financial need. Applicants must be current CSUF full-time (12 units) undergraduate or graduate students. Undergraduates must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 and graduates 3.5. All applicants must show academic achievement, active involvement in the Asian American and Pacific Islander community and/or student activities benefiting Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders, as well as financial need. Former recipients of this award are not eligible.

Essay Instructions

Write a 500-word essay that responds to the questions listed below. Number the sections of your essay to correspond to the questions. Applications without a written essay will not be considered.

1. Please describe any involvement in special projects, research, or papers that are part of your academic studies; and list the professor(s) with whom you worked. Include any honors or awards you may have received.
2. Please describe both your educational plans and professional goals and how you plan to accomplish them.
3. To which on-campus organizations do you belong? Please list names and dates of membership(s); names and dates of offices held; names and dates of organizational programs, projects, and events you were involved in; and what part you played.
4. Please respond to the same as above for organizational involvement in your community during the last three years.
5. Please explain how this award money will help you to fund your education. Include any other information that demonstrates your financial need.
