## Jane Stoakes Memorial Award

**Amount:** \$500 (variable)

**Established by:** An endowment funded by Kathy Biagi, daughter of Jane Stoakes, and the friends of Jane Stoakes, members of Visual Arts Prof. Don Lagerberg's weekend drawing group. This award is given annually to one or more art students with a background of course work, demonstrated abilities and sustaining interest in traditional, classical figure drawing.

**Open to:** This award is open to full-time or part-time undergraduate visual arts majors in art, art education, drawing and painting, illustration, printmaking, entertainment art/animation, sculpture; or graduate students in drawing and painting or illustration; or, a student in a 60+ Program. Previous recipients are ineligible.

**Criteria:** Artistic achievement with demonstrated abilities in traditional, classical figure drawing  
◆Evidence of a sustaining interest

**Application Procedure:** 1) The student applies by letter to the Chair, Department of Art, with a portfolio of 20-30 signed and dated original drawings (including life drawing, heads, and hands, narrative drawings, storyboards, character designs, etc.), done by the applicant as class work over not less than two semesters. The letter should include the applicant's name, major, class level, student number, email and telephone number, and a paragraph or two on the topic of traditional, classical figure drawing relative to the applicant. No slides, digital work or photocopies; 2) The materials are due in the Art Office by Friday, November 6, 2009, by 5:00 P.M., and may be dropped off any time during regular office hours between Wednesday, November 4 and Friday, November 6. The materials may be picked up during regular office hours on Monday or Tuesday, December 7 and 8.
