**Purpose:** Grant money is for activities associated with CSUF graduate student degree program research, and for travel associated with CSUF graduate student degree program studies. Awards will average \$100 - \$400.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

1. Applicants must be currently enrolled in a graduate degree program at CSUF, and must be in good academic standing.
2. Applicants must have filed a 2011 – 2012 FAFSA and have a demonstrated financial need.

**To apply:**

1. Applicants must submit a completed application form and a resume to the Office of Graduate Studies (MH-112). Application forms are available at [www.fullerton.edu/graduate](http://www.fullerton.edu/graduate).
2. Applicants must also request a confidential letter of support from a faculty member, to be sent directly to the Office of Graduate Studies (MH-112).

**Deadline:** Varies per semester

Applications will be reviewed throughout the spring semester. **Submittal deadlines for 2012 are: February 27 and April 23.** Applicants are encouraged to apply as early as possible within the context of the project's timeline.

## GRADUATE STUDENT RESEARCH FUND APPLICATION

In order to be eligible, applicants must be enrolled in a CSUF graduate program, have a minimum 3.0 Graduate GPA, and demonstrate financial need as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
