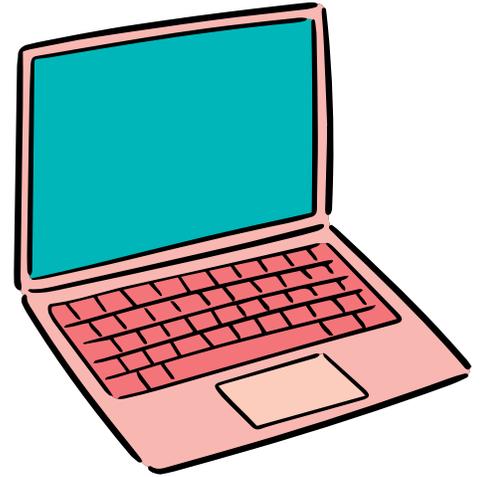
MESSAGE FROM CSUF GRADUATE STUDIES

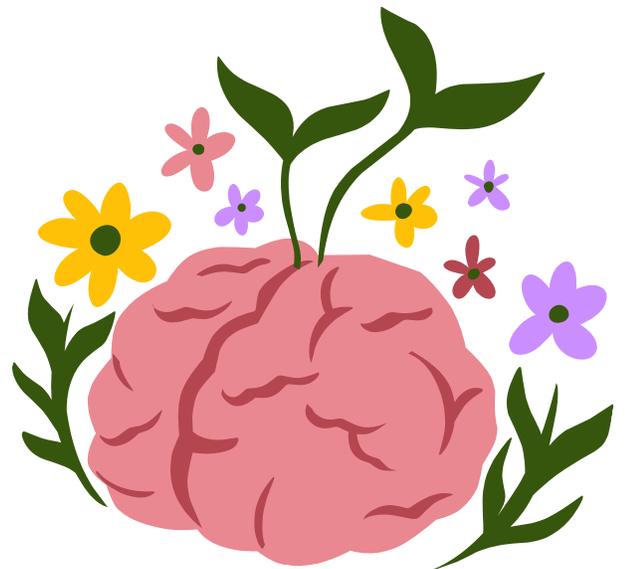
COUNSELING AND PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES (CAPS)

CA PRE-DOCTORAL PROGRAM (SALLY CASANOVA)

The CA Pre-Doctoral Program is designed to increase the diversity of the pool of potential faculty by supporting the doctoral aspirations of CSU students who have experienced economic and educational disadvantages. The program provides \$5,000 to visit doctoral granting institutions, participate in national symposia or professional meetings, and other related activities such as the cost of applying to doctoral programs.

Eligibility is limited to junior, senior, and graduate-level students who are enrolled in a degree-seeking program at any of the CSU campuses. International students are not eligible. Applications open on December 2, 2024 and will close on February 14, 2025.

CHANCELLOR'S DOCTORAL INCENTIVE PROGRAM

The mission of CDIP is to provide professional and academic support to doctoral students aspiring to teach the diverse students of the CSU system. CDIP also provides opportunities for professional development workshops, social connection, grant and research support, and if necessary, financial assistance in the form of a forgivable loan.

Applicants must meet one of the following criteria to apply: new or continuing full-time doctoral students currently enrolled in an accredited program in the U.S.; or are an individual in the process of applying to accredited doctoral programs in the U.S. for the upcoming year. Applicants enrolled in or applying to CSU EdD programs are not eligible. More information about the application timeline will be announced soon.
