Cal State Fullerton's Guardian Scholars Program is committed to supporting ambitious, college-bound students exiting the foster care system. We provide a comprehensive program that contributes to the quality and depth of the student's university experience. We serve as a resource for young adults by assisting in their development and equipping them with the educational and interpersonal skills necessary to become self-supporting, community leaders, role models, and competent professionals in their selected fields. By providing scholarship support that meets the university's full cost of attendance, the Guardian Scholars Program provides the opportunity to change individual lives and make dreams come true.

Each fall semester we hope to admit 10 to 15 new students into the Guardian Scholars Program with an ultimate goal of serving forty scholars in the program at one time.

Eligibility Requirements

In order to qualify for the Guardian Scholars Program students must apply and meet the following criteria:

- 1. Apply & qualify for admissions to Cal State Fullerton as a freshman or transfer student
- 2. Must be a current or former foster youth between the ages of 17-23
- 3. Be classified as a California Resident by the CSUF Office of Admission & Records
- 4. Demonstrate high motivation and academic potential to succeed in college
- 5. Must apply for FAFSA by the Priority Deadline of March 2nd & qualify as an "Independent" student under federal financial aid guidelines

- 6. Must apply & qualify for CSUF Educational Opportunity Program (EOP)

Requirements to Maintain Eligibility

To remain eligible for the program once the scholarship has been awarded, the recipient must:

- Maintain an overall 2.5 GPA or higher
- Maintain continuous enrollment at CSUF in at least 12 units of course work
- Fully participate in all aspects of the program (meetings, events, mentoring, etc.)
- Be receptive to staff monitoring academic performance and university records
- Abide by all university standards for appropriate conduct and community behavior
