International Research Experience for Students

The International Research Experience for Students (IRES) Program in Uzbekistan is funded by the National Science Foundation and by the California State University through Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation (LSAMP) program. Hosted at California State University Fullerton, the program provides U.S. students with 7-week research experiences in Mathematics and Computer Science under the mentorship of Urgench State University faculty. Uzbekistan is the birthplace of algebra and algorithm, and is home to several ancient Silk Road cities. As part of the cultural component of the program, participants will travel to Samarkand, Bukhara and Khiva to learn about cultural and scientific heritage of Uzbekistan.

Program Eligibility

- Participants of the CSU-LSAMP program
- Current junior and senior level undergraduate students
- Must enroll as a college-level student in Fall 2023
- STEM majors with a minimum of 3.0 GPA
- May not take courses during the program
- No prior research experience required
- Must attend week-long introductory lectures (Online)
