Hot Food Will Return

Food Service at the Irvine Campus for fall 2010 will include hot meal services to complement snacks that can be purchased at the Bookstore/Café on campus. We contracted briefly with Stadium Brewery during the final month of Spring 2010 as a test run to see if students, faculty and staff would be attracted to quality and price of items offered by this company. Although the number of meals sold did not reach levels sought by the vendor; consistent positive reactions were received from those who did purchase meals. An additional vendor with quality products offered from mobile units recently inquired about providing additional hot food services to our students during the fall term. We expect proposals from Stadium Brewery and this unnamed additional vendor within the coming month to prepare for our fall "hot" food services.

Helpful Hints

Xerox Copier (IRVC)

- After entering your code to make copies, your default drawers are 4 then 3 (backwards from the previous copier). Selecting drawer 1 will cause your job not to print unless it is loaded with color paper.

- Drawer 1 is for color copies only (request all color paper from IRVC250), this drawer will be empty by default, unless loaded with color paper. Therefore, the display will read drawer 1 needs to be loaded.

- If your job isn't printing and you have confirmed you are on the default (automatic) drawer, or drawer 4 or 3, you will need to clear all the jobs blocking printing under the "Job Status" button.
