Who can check-out?

- Rooms maybe checked out by currently enrolled CSUF students, with no holds.
- Rooms are intended for student class/study-related purposes only.
- Rooms must be checked out to groups of two (2) or more students.

Where can I check-out?

- Information & Learning Commons (ILC) Support Services, 1st Floor, Library North
- Students must:
 - o Be registered as a current CSUF student and have a TitanCard
 - o Have at least 2 students present both with valid TitanCards
 - o Leave a valid TitanCard
 - o Sign a liability waiver accepting responsibility for the equipment
 - o Not have prior holds

How long do rooms check out?

• Rooms may be checked out for two hours.

Reservations and Renewals

- Smart Group Study Rooms may be reserved up to 1 week in advance, online: http://apps.fullerton.edu/ilcreserve
- Rooms can be renewed only if there are no reservations and no one else is waiting for the room.
