

Internet Explorer

Steps	Images
<p>Step One</p> <hr/> <p>Click on the Settings icon () on the far right. Select Internet Options from the drop-down menu.</p>	
<p>Step Two</p> <hr/> <p>Under the General tab click on the Delete button under the Browsing history section.</p> <p>Check ‘Temporary Internet files and website files’ and ‘Cookies and website data’</p> <p>We recommend also unchecking Preserve Favorites website data to efficiently clear all cookies and cache.</p> <p>Click Delete.</p> <p>Click OK to finish.</p>	




<p>Step One</p> <p>At the top right of the browser, click on the three dots and click on Settings.</p> <p>Under the Privacy & Security section, click on Choose what to clear.</p>	 <p>The image shows the Microsoft Edge browser interface. 

Mozilla Firefox (Smartphone/Tablet)

<p>Step One</p> <hr/> <p>Note: These steps are done on an iPhone but are similar on other devices.</p> <p>Tap on the three dots either at the top right of your screen or at the bottom. Then, tap on Settings.</p> <p>In the Settings window, tap on Clear Private Data.</p>	
<p>Step Two</p> <hr/> <p>Make sure that Cookies and Cache are checked.</p> <p>Click on OK.</p>	



Google Chrome

Steps	Images
<p>Step One</p> <p>In the browser bar, enter: chrome://settings/clearBrowserData.</p>	
<p>Step Two</p> <p>Make sure the following boxes are checked:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Browsing history • Download history • Cached images and files • Cookies and other site and plug-in data <p>Make sure the beginning of time is selected under the Clear the following items: drop-down menu.</p> <p>Click Clear browsing data.</p>	


Google Chrome (Smartphone/Tablet)

Steps	Images
<p>Step One</p> <hr/> <p>At the top right of the screen, select the three dots then select Settings.</p> <p>Under Advanced, select Privacy.</p>	
<p>Step Two</p> <hr/> <p>Scroll down, then select Clear browsing data.</p> <p>Make sure to Clear data from the beginning of time and Cookies and site data and Cached images and files are checked.</p> <p>Select Clear Data.</p>	



Built-in Android Browser

Steps	Images
<p>Step One</p> <hr/> <p>Tap on the More button on the far right and tap Settings.</p>	
<p>Step Two</p> <hr/> <p>Tap Privacy.</p> <p>Then tap Delete personal data. Make sure Cache and Cookies and site data are checked.</p> <p>Tap on Delete.</p>
