4. Choose and download the software based on your operating system.
5. Extract files and Install Read&Write
6. Login to your school google account to activate Read&Write



CLICK ON:


Download (on the top right corner of the page)

LOCATE:


The installation file in the extracted folder

CLICK:


Accept and Install

LOCATE:


The Read&Write icon on your Desktop


SELECT:

Read&Write is now Installed & Activated




Where is Read&Write Located? (Windows)
