






Texthelp Read&Write download & installation instructions



1. Get the software from <http://www.fullerton.edu/it/services/software/index.php> by clicking on the **Read&Write** link.
2. Login and accept the End User License Agreement (EULA).
3. Choose and Install the software based on your operating system.
4. Check if your Read&Write installation was successful.

<p>Step One</p> <p>Go to http://www.fullerton.edu/it/services/software/index.php and click on Read&Write.</p>	
<p>Step Two</p> <p>Type in your Portal username and password.</p> <p>Then click Login.</p>	
<p>Step Three</p> <p>Scroll down to the bottom and click on the check box to accept the terms of the End User License Agreement (EULA).</p>	
<p>Step Four</p> <p>You will then see a Download Read&Write button.</p> <p>Click on it to retrieve the Read&Write software.</p>	



<p>Step One (Mac)</p> <p>Locate the installation file you download in the above step.</p> <p>Double click on the file to extract the file.</p> <p>Open the Mac Installation file.</p> <p>If you receive the error message: “Install” is damaged and can’t be opened. 

1. Click on **Apple** menu

5. On the **General** tab under **Allow apps downloaded from** select **Anywhere**
6. Click **Allow from anywhere**
7. Click on the **lock** icon to save changes
8. Close the **Security & Privacy** window

<p>Step Three (Mac)</p> <p>Click on the Activate button to launch the program.</p> <p>Note: If you cannot activate your product, please contact the Student IT Help Desk (hours and contact information is found at the end of the guide).</p>	

Windows Computers

<p>Step One (Windows)</p> <p>Locate the installation file you download in the above step.</p> <p>Right click the Setup.zip file and click Extract All.</p> <p>Click Extract.</p>	 
<p>Step Two (Windows)</p> <p>Double click on Setup.exe.</p>	

<p>Step Three (Windows)</p> <p>Wait for the installation.</p> <p>It may take a couple of minutes for the installation to finish.</p>	
<p>Step Four (Windows)</p> <p>Open Read&Write by clicking on the icon on your desktop.</p>	
<p>Step Five (Windows)</p> <p>Click Activate.</p> <p>You will receive confirmation that your activation was successful in a new window.</p> <p>Note: If you cannot activate your product, please contact the Student IT Help Desk (hours and contact information is found at the end of the guide).</p>
