Job Description

Graders work under the direct supervision of individual faculty to evaluate student homework and quizzes for a term appointment.

Job Expectations

- Graders will work collaboratively and maintain clear communication with faculty who will be their supervisor.
- Graders will submit graded homework/quizzes in a timely manner as determined by supervisor.
- Graders will evaluate student work consistent with standards set by supervisor.

Eligibility

Applicants for an Instructional Student Assistant position must have:

- At least one recently completed college level math course with a grade of "B" or better.
- Contact information for at least one prior college level math instructor.
- Competency to grade homework and quizzes in assigned math course.
- Enrolled in 6 units of undergraduate or graduate coursework for the entire semester.
- Authorized to work in the U.S.

Application Process

- 1. Submit an online application.
 - a. Federal Work Study students: Apply here.
 - b. Non-Federal Work Study applicants: Apply here.
- 2. Faculty will review the applicant pool and will select an applicant to grade for him/her. There is no interview process.
- 3. The selected applicant will be notified to begin hiring and payroll onboarding process.
- 4. Selected applicant must be fully hired prior to beginning work assignment.

Salary and Hours

Salary: \$15/hour

Hours: Normal grading assignments vary from 2 hours to 12 hours a week. Students may work no more than a total of 20 hours per week.
