The McNair Scholars Program accepts applications year-round, but scholars do not begin the program until the summer *after* their acceptance. If you are applying during the Spring Semester, please contact Director Gerald Bryant (657-278-7315) to find out the cutoff date for applications in Spring.

McNair Program Eligibility Checklist

Use this list to verify that you are eligible to be a McNair Scholar

- More than 59 units completed by the end of the upcoming Spring semester
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above
- Low-income*
- first-generation college student** AND/OR underrepresented in graduate education*
- U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Currently enrolled at CSUF
- Expect to graduate from CSUF with a bachelor's degree

*Low-income is defined by the federal government using the family's taxable income. To find out if you meet the requirements for "low income," check the McNair Scholars Program website (www.fullerton.edu/mcnair) as it changes yearly.

** First generation college is defined by the Federal government as a student who has not resided with or received primary support from a parent who has received a bachelor's degree or equivalent.

*** The following ethnic and racial groups are currently underrepresented in graduate education: Black (non-Hispanic), Hispanic, and American Indian/Alaskan Native.

Requirements of the McNair Scholars Program

If you are accepted into the McNair Scholars Program at CSUF, there are a few things that will be expected of you. You will be required to:

- Attend group monthly meetings**
- Attend at least 4 workshops a semester.**
- Complete an original research project with the help of a faculty mentor (a \$2800 stipend is awarded for completion)**
- Meet with the Academic Coordinator on a regular basis (weekly or biweekly)**
- Provide McNair with copies of your syllabi each semester**
- Submit a Progress Report each semester signed by your professors**

McNair Scholars Program Application Checklist

The following items must be submitted for you to be eligible:

- McNair Scholars Program Application
- Official Transcripts of all higher education institutions attended
- Personal Statement
- Copy of Financial Aid form (either FAFSA or SAR)
- One current letter of recommendation and completion of form by a faculty member

Your application cannot be evaluated unless all of the necessary materials have been received. Applications submitted in person should be turned in between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. to the reception staff at the McNair Office LH-809.
