

What is a Mystery Hangout?	 Two classrooms connecting via a Google Hangout video chat Game: 20 yes/no questions Guess the other classroom's
Why do Mystery Hangouts?	 Foster communication and collaboration Take learning outside your classroom walls Highly engaging Real world connection → Makes learning more relevant Develop language in authentic way
What does a Mystery Hangout Iook like?	 Determine what to guess before the Mystery Hangout: number, state, country 30-45 minutes All students participating → true collaboration Teach etiquette
Student Roles	Choose what works best with your students! Greeters Questioners Recorders Runner/s Mappers (ALL students) Photographers and/or Videographers
