CSUF ACADEMIC POLICIES

Academic Probation: CSUF GPA falls below a 2.0

Academic Disqualification (DQ): a student is no longer considered an "admitted/matriculated" student at CSUF because their GPA does not meet the minimum GPA required (based on class level) for two consecutive semesters. See advisors for more info.

How do I get off of Academic Probation? Minimum 2.0 CSUF GPA is required in order to remain in good academic standing. **Meet with your NSM Student Success Team for help!**

Course Repeat Policy

Students may repeat up to **28 units**: Grade forgiveness will be automatically applied to the first **16 units** repeated and the remaining **12 units** will be averaged. Meet with NSM Student Success Team if you have any questions.

Add/Drop Period (01/23-02/09): You must drop via Titan Online. Late fees can be required. Check with advisor if you have any questions.

Withdrawal Period (Non-Medical) (02/10 - 02/22): Withdraw from classes with a 'W' for serious and compelling reasons with permission from the department. For more information visit: <http://records.fullerton.edu/services/withdrawal.php>
