

**University Policy Statement
California State University, Fullerton**

EMERITUS STATUS

1. Emeritus status shall be granted to a faculty member at CSUF after at least ten years of full-time status upon:
 - a. Retirement.
 - b. Death while still in full-time service.
 - c. The President may use his/her discretion in initiating and granting emeritus rank in exceptional cases.
2. Emeritus status shall be granted at the highest academic rank held by an individual while an active member of the faculty.
3. Emeritus status of a retired individual shall be indicated appropriately in the Catalog during his/her lifetime.
4. The privilege of emeritus status for retired faculty shall include:
 - a. Use of the Emeritus Professors' office.
 - b. A special staff identification card from the Office of the President, which will entitle the user to special faculty facilities including library privileges and, with the consent of the Associated Students, to regular faculty discounts on all campus activities and entertainment events.
 - c. Eligibility for every University committee with exception of the all-University Personnel Committee.
 - d. Eligibility for service on thesis committees.
 - e. Eligibility for service as substitute teachers.
 - f. Such other privileges as the Faculty, Emeriti, Associated Students, and the State of California may from time to time create.
