IV. ELECTIONS

Chair Walker announced the election of the 2015-16 Executive Committee stating the procedure to elect (7) officer positions. Nominations will be taken from the floor with a second, and nominees must accept the nomination. Prior to voting, each first-time nominee will be given (optional) opportunity to speak for a maximum of 2-minutes to accept a nomination. If position is uncontested, the person will be elected to the position by acclimation. When a position has multiple candidates, to be elected a majority of senators is required (one over half/ 21 needed). When there are more than two candidates for a position, and no candidate receives a majority, the candidate with the lowest number of votes will be eliminated, and another vote will be taken. This process will be repeated until one candidate receives a majority vote.

With assistance from Rommel Hidalgo, 41 radio-frequency clickers were distributed to eligible participants and instructions given. Chair Walker repeated a roll call in order to complete accuracy of the clicker-response.
